

Audio-Visual Technology in Ministry Summer Internship at Herndon UMC

Herndon United Methodist Church (UMC) is seeking an Audio-Visual Technology intern for Summer 2025. The position is designed to give a hands-on learning opportunity to widen knowledge and develop skills and experience with presentation technology in a church ministry setting. This is an 8-week program (June to August) with flexible start and end dates and work hours to accommodate students' summer schedules. Interns will be scheduled for 80 total hours of work during the summer, which will include Sunday morning technology support, as well as technology support to weekday activities, including summer camps. Interns will gain practical experience and hone technical skills in audio production, software, hardware, streaming and recording techniques, sound design, organization, and problem-solving. At the conclusion of the internship, interns will present a summary of their work to the church community.

Basic qualifications:

- Professional behavior, including timeliness and prompt communication.
- Ability to simultaneously work on multiple projects and meet deadlines.
- A positive, teamwork-focused attitude
- Leadership skills and the ability to take initiative
- Must be comfortable climbing ladders and crawling into tight spaces, and able to lift a minimum of 40 lbs

Preferred qualifications:

- Prior audio-visual technology experience
- Experience in music or theatre

Compensation and hours:

- Sunday morning hours are required; additional hours will be set according to the intern's schedule and will not exceed 40 hours per work week or 80 total work hours.
- Compensation is \$1000, paid hourly.
